A Medical Home

A Medical Home means that families receive medical care and support through a team of providers and care coordinators working together.

“Working with a care coordinator helps organize all our family medical and social needs”

Family Partnerships

A family who enrolls with our program has a dedicated care coordinator to help them.

The coordinator will work together with families and providers to support individual needs.

Our services are ongoing or on a needs basis.

Care Coordinators

Our care coordinators are registered nurses who have worked in pediatrics for over 20 years.

A care coordinator can:

- Help families assess needs and advocate for them.
- Provide linkages to specialists and community resources.
- Assist with school-based services and provide feedback.
- Create a care plan that works for your child and family needs.

Eligibility

Children and youth from birth to 21 who have a positive score result on our screener tool.

The screener tool is a quick assessment to help identify a need and medical complexity.

A provider or family can fill out the screener.
