# INSTRUCTIONS FOR PANENDOSCOPY (EGD) or ESOPHAGOSCOPY with HALO Radiofrequency Ablation

- 1. You are to have nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before the procedure.
- 2. Someone must be available to drive you home following the procedure.
- 3. One week prior to the procedure do not take Aspirin products, anti inflammatory medications such as Ibuprofen, Aleve, Naprosyn, Motrin or items on the attached list. **You may take Tylenol**.
- 4. Do not take blood thinners such as Coumadin, Plavix or Pradaxa for one week prior to the procedure.
- 5. You should be taking a medicine to reduce the secretion of acid from your stomach, such as Protonix, Nexium, Dexilant, Aciphex or Prevacid.
- 6. It is important to let the doctor know if you have any allergies. IF YOU ARE A DIABETIC, you are to take your medication as follows:
  7. The following medications should be taken with a small sip of water PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE.
