### **Patient Population**

- We are a Level III Labor and Delivery unit who cares for a high-risk population during women's labor and delivery experience. For example, many patients we care for might have pre-eclampsia, gestational diabetes, preterm labor, multiple gestation, fetal anomalies, cardiac conditions, etc.
- All of our nurses are trained to labor, delivery, recovery, antepartum, postpartum, newborn care, and circulating and scrubbing in the Operating Room
- St. Francis is a teaching hospital, and our staff work closely with OB Residents

### **Prior Experience Suggested**

- Obstetric and/or fetal monitoring experience preferred
- Capstone or internship in obstetrics preferred if new graduate

### **Orientation**

- $\geq 16$  weeks includes didactic, simulations, classes, and unit-based training
- BLS, NRP, NCC Certification in Electronic Fetal Monitoring (within 1 year of hire)
